HIGHER COURT IN BELGRADE

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 47.1 of the Law on International Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters, on the basis of Article 331.1, 2 and Article 332 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, and in connection with Article 43.3 (5) of the Criminal Procedure Code and Articles 3 and 4 of the Law on the Organization and Competence of State Authorities in War Crimes Proceedings, I am taking over the prosecution based on the confirmed indictment of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina no. T20 0 KTRZ 0017499 19 from 30 December 2020, confirmed on 11 January 2021, and I am revising it according to the laws of the Republic of Serbia, so that it reads as follows:

INDICTMENT

Against:

Due to the fact that the aforementioned had carried out the following:

During the war in Bosnia and Herzegovina, the armed conflict between the army and the police of the Republika Srpska of B-H and the Republika Srpska and the Army of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in the municipality of Bosanska Krupa in the period from July 1992 to September 1992, AA, in the capacity of a member of the reserve police force at the Bosanska Krupa Public Security Station, in the area of the municipality of Bosanska Krupa, acted contrary to the rules of international humanitarian law, thereby violating the provisions of Article 3 of the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949, by executing the following:

1. In the second half of July 1992, in the evening hours, 44 camp inmates, Bosniak and Croat civilians, were taken out of the Omarska Camp located in the territory of the municipality of Prijedor, for an alleged exchange that was supposed to take place in the territory of the municipality of Bosanska Krupa. These were civilians of Bosniak and Croatian nationality: AB, AV, AG, AD, AĐ, AE, AŽ, AZ, AI, AJ, AK, AL, ALj, AM, AN, ANj, AO, AP, AR, AS, AT, AĆ, AU, AF, AH, AC, AČ, ADž, AŠ, BA, BV, BG, BD, BĐ, BE, BŽ, BZ, BI, BJ, BK, BL, BLj, BM and one NN civilian, who were in a minibus TAM 130 on the way for an alleged exchange, when, by order of AA, they were taken out of the minibus to Donji Dubovik, municipality of Bosanska Krupa, after which AA and BB (according to which the proceedings were separated by the decision of the Court of B-H into S1 1 K 038748 20 Kro and S1 1 K 041736 21 Kro, dated 30 November 2021), tied them up with wires, and then AA, BB and VV (deceased), holding automatic rifles, took them to the so-called nearby Lisac pit, and shot dead the 44 Bosniak and Croat civilians, in order for the bodies of the mentioned civilians to be found in 2000 during the exhumation in the Lisac pit, in Donji Dubovik, municipality of Bosanska Krupa.

2. At the beginning of August 1992, in the town of Donji Dubovik, municipality of Bosanska Krupa, AA and BB had intercepted 7 civilians of Bosniak nationality who were moving from Prijedor towards Bihać: BM, BN, BNj, BO, BP, BR and BS, and immediately afterwards they were shot dead, after which the bodies of the mentioned civilians were found and identified during the exhumation in Donji Dubovik, municipality of Bosanska Krupa, in the Lisac pit in 2000,

- by which the criminal offense of war crimes against the civilian population from Article 142.1 of the CC of the FRY in relation to Article 22 of the CC of the FRY was committed.
